End of Watch: 11/22/1924

Constable Mills was on post at the intersection of Post Road West and Riverside Avenue on November 22, 1924, directing heavy traffic returning from the Yale – Harvard football game. At 6:10 PM he was struck by a car returning to New York City from that game. Constable Mills suffered head and leg injuries and died 4 days later as a result of a traumatic brain injury.

Constable Mills was 65 years old when he was killed, and a newspaper account of the accident and his death noted that "...in spite of his years he was a most efficient officer. Faithfulness was his motto in this as well as everything he undertook."
